Our speaker at both services will be Shan Tatum, representing I Pour Life, a non-profit focused on developing people and providing the tools needed to become self-sufficient.

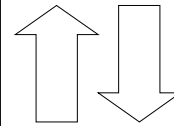

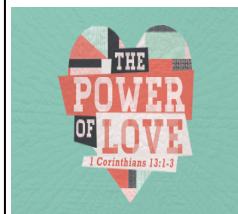

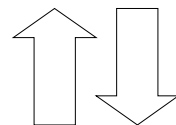
