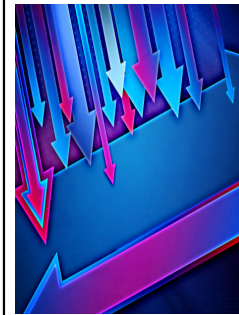

There is a "Wiggle Room" (first room on the left in the north hall) for parents to use if their babies and toddlers need a break during the service.



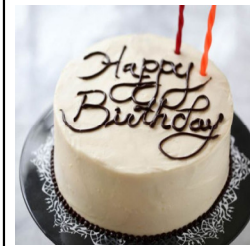
Wednesday Night Dinner January 11th - 5:30
