Living On Purpose

Greetings, Asbury friends!

I write to you on New Year's Eve, that transitional day of gratefully celebrating and appreciating what God has accomplished in the past year and looking forward with eager anticipation to the adventures God has in mind for the new year. What a joy it is to be on this journey with you!

We will open our new year with a Wesley covenant service on Epiphany Sunday, January 5th. Then, beginning January 12th, we enter a six-week series about living On Purpose.

Trying to discover the purpose of our lives can lead to a lot of questions. Who am I? Why am I here? What does living with purpose look like? Have you ever asked this question: Why am I here? Do I have a "calling"? What am I supposed to do with my life? What does purposeful living look like? Often, the world is all too ready to give us answers — promising that finding the perfect job or achieving the next milestone will make us happy. But in our next sermon series, we will embrace the questions as an invitation to discover what it is that God wants to do with the story of our lives.

How do we think about our direction or purpose as a church? We say things like "we are the body of Christ." "We make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world." What does that mean practically and how do we live it out? Do we, as a church, stay open to the leading of the Spirit that blows where it will? Are we open to doing things differently so we can grow together as a church in our relationship with God?

Our 2025 Mission/Vision team will be prayerfully considering these questions this year as we seek God's direction for Asbury ministries. We are asking God to help us build on the groundwork already laid—making prayer a priority, allowing ourselves to be re-shaped, celebrating connections, saying yes to God's leading, recognizing gifts God has given us, and trusting that with God all things are possible. We thank God for those who agreed to serve on our Mission/Vision Team, and those who will serve on our Leadership Development Team. You have an opportunity to play an important part in their leadership by praying for them! You can start praying for them today. And, during worship on January 12th, we will set aside time to offer a special blessing and prayer over these teams.

Friends, I look forward to seeing God's work unfold in and through us, this remarkable Asbury family.
